## Matau Designs

## You will need:

A4 card

Contact paper

Sticky tape

Natural resources (leaves, small sticks, feathers, shells, pebbles, wool, seeds. flowers)

Glue



## Instructions

- 1. Use matau shapes as stencils on the cardboard and then cut them out.
- 2. Measure a piece of contact paper that fits the size of your card. Use sticky tape to attach the shiny side of the contact paper to the table.
- 3. Peel off the paper backing and lay your cut—out cardboard with matau shapes cut out of it onto the contact paper.



4. Decorate the exposed sticky shapes with natural materials. (You can cover this with another sheet of cardboard or contact paper and display on the wall or in the windows.)
