Muri Paraoa Designs



You will need:

A4 card

Contact paper


Sticky tape

Natural resources (leaves, small sticks, feathers, shells, pebbles, wool, seeds. flowers)
Glue



Instructions

- I. Use Muri Paraoa shapes as stencils on the cardboard and then cut them out. You will have a Muri Paraoa—shaped hole in the cardboard.
- 2. Measure a piece of contact paper that fits the size of your card. Use sticky tape to attach the shiny side of the contact paper to the table.
- 3. Peel off the paper backing and lay your cardboard with the Muri Paraoa—shaped holes onto the contact paper.
- 4. Decorate the exposed sticky shapes with natural materials. (You can cover this with another sheet of cardboard or contact paper and display on the wall or in the windows.)
