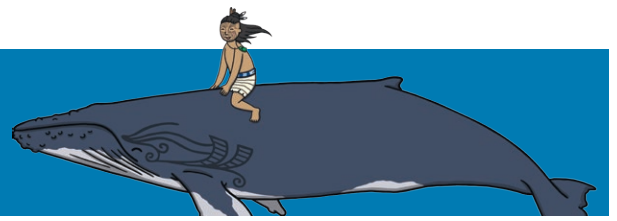


Muri Paraoa Designs



You will need:

A4 card

Contact paper

Sticky tape

Natural resources (leaves, small sticks, feathers, shells, pebbles, wool, seeds, flowers)

Glue

Instructions

1. Use Muri Paraoa shapes as stencils on the cardboard and then cut them out. You will have a Muri Paraoa-shaped hole in the cardboard.
2. Measure a piece of contact paper that fits the size of your card. Use sticky tape to attach the shiny side of the contact paper to the table.
3. Peel off the paper backing and lay your cardboard with the Muri Paraoa-shaped holes onto the contact paper.
4. Decorate the exposed sticky shapes with natural materials. (You can cover this with another sheet of cardboard or contact paper and display on the wall or in the windows.)

huruhuru — feather

kōhatu — pebble

ngā rau — leaves

manga — twig

ngā angaanga — shells

ngā putiputi — flowers

ngā puapua — petals

ngā purapura — seeds

harakeke — flax

onepū — sand
